The CAM 61 camera system is designed to assist crane operators by enhancing their visibility and safety during lifting operations. While it doesn't replace operator judgment, it provides valuable support in sensitive or risky situations. Installed on the trolley or the jib of luffing cranes, the camera delivers clear views of the work area, regardless of weather conditions. With its powerful zoom and high light sensitivity, operators can precisely monitor the load's position and surrounding environment.
